**NMCRL-WEB** is an interactive codification screening application containing the following data :

- 2 million Manufacturers and Vendors (NCAGE codes, names and addresses)
- 26 million User Registrations
- 10 million NSNs with TECHNICAL CHARACTERISTICS
- 9 million NSNs with CUSTOM CODES display
- 13 million NSNs with CPV CODES display

### Search Modules:

- <ITEM of SUPPLY> : Search on all codification data codes and/or names cross-related to the Item of Supply (NSN)
- <CHARACTERISTICS> : Item of Supply identification by searching on Technical Characteristics data
- <NCAGE> : World wide search on complete Manufacturer and Vendor data (addresses and related codes)
- <BATCH> : Automatic extraction of grouped codification
